Marks, Reporting and Assessments

Will all students receive a final mark for June? Yes, all students will receive a final mark for June.

How will my child be assessed for the Final report card?

Teachers will consider the unique learning needs or circumstances that students may require during this pandemic. As such, the June report card will be based on the following:

Students that participated in Term 3;

• a 'third term mark for the final grade will be based on demonstrated learning that has occurred during on-line and in-class learning.

Students that did not participate in Term 3;

• the teacher's professional judgment regarding assessments and learning that was demonstrated in terms 1 and 2 will be used to determine a final grade for June.

Note

No student will have a lower final grade than they would have had prior to Spring Break. However, students may 'improve' their grade if they demonstrate a higher level of understanding through their on-line or in-school learning after Spring Break.

Assessment of additional learning is best determined individually by each teacher in conversation with students or from a personally observed task completion/understanding, rather than through the collection of written assignments.
