### <u>Travel Requirements Following Return to Canada - Important if you traveled out of Canada over Spring Break!</u>

Staff, students, and families are responsible for understanding and adhering to all COVID-19 international travel requirements outlined by the Government of Canada, including those required following return to Canada.

Requirements currently include that adults and children (aged 5 and older) who **travelled internationally must wear a well-constructed and well-fitting mask in in-door and outdoor public spaces, including K–12 schools, for the first 14 days after entry.** This means wearing a mask at schools is not a personal choice for those who have travelled internationally for 14 days after entry.

Adults and children must also monitor for symptoms for 14 days after entry and follow federal requirements for self isolation and quarantine if symptoms develop and/or they test positive for COVID-19.

#### Mask and COVID-19 Update

As of April 4th, masks are no longer required at PRMS. However, students or adults may have varying levels of comfort regarding COVID-19. Some members of our school community may choose to continue to wear a mask and we will respect everyone's personal choice. Please continue to monitor for symptoms and stay home if you are sick.

Please come to the office to pick up a box of Covid-19 Tests for your child.

#### **Green Shirt Day**

Students and staff are encouraged to wear a green shirt on Thursday, April 7 in honour of Logon Boulet Effect, in support of organ donor awareness.

#### **Report Cards**

Report Cards will be going home with students by Friday, April 14. A message will go home when they are given out to students.

#### **Daily Health Checks**

A daily health check is a tool to reduce the likelihood of a person with COVID-19 coming to school when they are infectious.

- Parents/caregivers and students can utilize the new provincial K-12 Health Check app at https://www2.gov.bc.ca/assets/gov/education/kindergarten-to-grade-12/covid/daily-health-check-english.pdf
- Staff and other adults must complete a daily health check prior to entering the school.
- If a student, staff or adult is sick, they must not enter the school. Please keep you child home if they are not feeling well.

#### **Homework club**

Every Wednesday, from 2:04pm-3:04pm students are invited to Homework club.

#### **Dropping off/Picking up students**

When dropping off your child in the morning, please do not stop in the crosswalk. This can be very dangerous as drivers have a difficult time seeing the pedestrians. Please do not drive into the school entrance. Students are to be picked up and dropped off on the street, in the side parking lot, by the golf course or the Civic Centre. Areas painted yellow in the parking lot are no parking zones. Please don't park by the cones.

#### **Supervision**

The school is opened at 8:15am each school day. Doors are kept locked until then.

#### **Breakfast Program**

The school Breakfast program is available to students beginning at 8:15am each school day.
