Please do not drive into the school entrance, students are to be picked up and dropped off on the street, in the side parking lot, by the golf course, or the Civic Centre. Areas painted yellow in the parking lot are no parking zones.

Cellphones

Just a reminder that students are not supposed to have cellphones at school during the day. If they bring them to school, they are required to be kept in their locker. Please do not text or call your child during the day. If you need to get a hold of them, please contact the school.
