PRMS early works has begun. Construction fencing will remain around active construction areas as we begin work on the new PRMS. Students, staff and parents are asked not to access any of the fenced areas for the duration of the project.

Playground removal will commence soon. The playground will be relocated to a new location on school grounds after the new building is constructed.

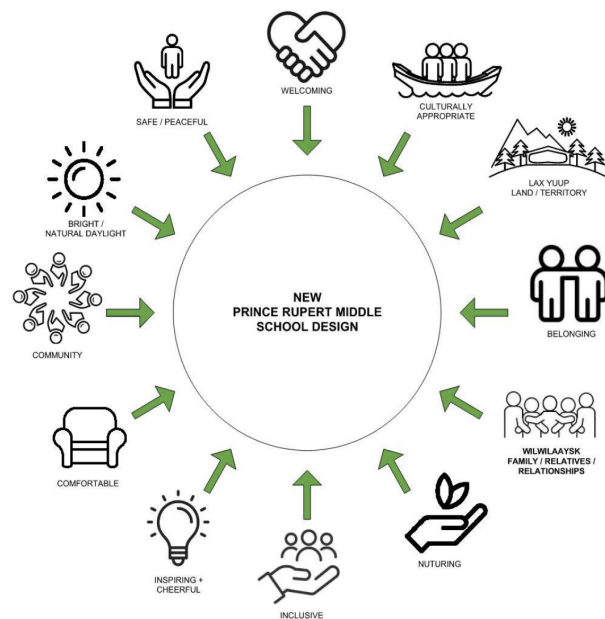

On Monday January 27<sup>th</sup>, students will return to some concrete waste and a small pile of debris inside the construction fencing. Fencing will remain around the excavated foundation area of the demolished band room.

Construction of a new access road from 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue is planned to be completed by the beginning of March. The old access road will be decommissioned and fenced at this time.
