Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to December! The weather is getting colder and very wet so please make sure your child is dressed for the weather. There will be days that students will be going outside during rainy and windy weather. It's getting darker in the mornings as well, so make sure students are aware of traffic in the Civic Center parking lot at the beginning and the end of the day. We had a busy November with a thoughtful Remembrance Day assembly, subway day, dress in something representing your culture, house team color day, Fancy Friday, and grade group assemblies. School spirit participation is very important for students so they can experience school fun school belonging.

Supervision

The school is opened at 8:15am.

Breakfast Program

The school Breakfast program is available to students beginning at 8:15am each school day.

Port Pancake Breakfast

On December 4th employees from the Port of Prince Rupert will be cooking a wonderful pancake breakfast for students in the breakfast club.

Water Advisory Bring Water Bottles

We are currently on a boil water advisory. Unfortunately, this happens often in Prince Rupert. We do not always have paper cups or drinking water available to give students. Please make sure that your child brings a **full** water bottle to school.

Parent/Guardian Visitors

If you need to see your child during the school day, you must stay at the office, and the office staff will be happy to assist you. For the safety of our students and staff, please do not wander the halls of the school or enter your child's classroom.

Dropping off/Picking up Students

Please be aware of the students walking or running through the Civic Center parking lot when dropping off and picking up your child. Students are needing to catch the city bus at their new location and will be doing so for the next few months with construction happening on 9th Avenue. We discuss daily how they need to be safe in the parking lot.

Conflict Resolution for Parent Concerns

Most concerns that arise at school can be solved through communication with your student's teacher. Depending on the concern or issue a phone call, email, or meeting can be made with the classroom teacher. If necessary and the concern has not been resolved, then the principal and vice-principal can be contacted, and a meeting can be scheduled. If, after first communicating with the teacher, then the principal, a resolution is not reached at the school level, a parent may then contact the School Board Office. We have flyers available with more information called "Conflict Resolution Process for Parent Concerns."

Cellphones/Electronic Devices

While teachers may permit the occasional use of cell phones or other electronic devices (headphones, airpods, ipads, etc) in the classroom for educational purposes, outside of these times students are required to keep their devices in their locker from 8:45am to 3:03pm (2:05pm on Wednesday), including break times. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to enable, if available, the find my device feature on their student's phone. School staff are not responsible for these devices and are unable to search for them should they go missing. If you need to contact your child during the school day, please call the office and leave them a message.

Social Media

The school is not responsible for events that take place on social media, we do not have access to students' cellphones, nor do we monitor what they do on social media. If they are using school computers or iPads, they are not permitted on social media such as Instagram, Snapchat, Facebook, etc., during school hours. Please be aware of what may happen on social media with your child.

Personal Belongings

Please be aware that student's personal belongings are not the school's responsibility. Students are to keep their personal belongings in their locker, locked and safe so they do not get lost or stolen. Please discuss this with your child so they do not lose any important personal belongings. We recommend that money, cellphones, or any important items be kept at home or securely locked in lockers.

Lost & Found

We have a large amount of student clothing, coats, shoes, and water bottles in our lost and found. They have been placed out on tables in our school foyer for students to see and go through. If your child is missing anything, please ask them to look through the lost and found items. We will have them out in the foyer until our Winter Craft Night. After this, they will be placed in our school clothing for other students to use when needed.
