Conflict Resolution for Parent Concerns

Most concerns that arise at school can be solved through communication with your student's teacher. Depending on the concern or issue a phone call, email, or meeting can be made with the classroom teacher. If necessary and the concern has not been resolved, then the principal and vice-principal can be contacted, and a meeting can be scheduled. If, after first communicating with the teacher, then the principal, a resolution is not reached at the school level, a parent may then contact the School Board Office. Social Media

The school is not responsible for events that take place on social media, we do not have access to students' cellphones, nor do we monitor what they do on social media. If they are using school computers or iPads, they are not permitted on social media such as Instagram, Snapchat, Facebook, Tik Toc, etc., during school hours. Please be aware of what may happen on social media with your child.

Personal Belongings

Please be aware that student's personal belongings are not the school's responsibility. Students are to keep their personal belongings in their locker, locked and safe so they do not get lost or stolen, this includes binders. Please discuss this with your child so they do not lose any important personal belongings. We recommend that money, cellphones, or any important items be kept at home or securely locked in lockers.
